We have some unrestricted data formats, such as XML or JSON. To redeliver this data, we need to create a plan. It is similar to the previous process, but we cannot perform data quality checks on this type of data. We need to create the data in XML Insight to use data quality checks. There are many functions inside the Ataccama, such as fixing grid files. We can read dispute finance data in the web app and generate reports. Currently, we need to create the component or dispute. Then, the data comes into the room in a stable format, and we can easily upload it to change the data quality.

Overall, I rate the product an eight out of ten..”

Based on all factors, I would rate it 8 out of 10.

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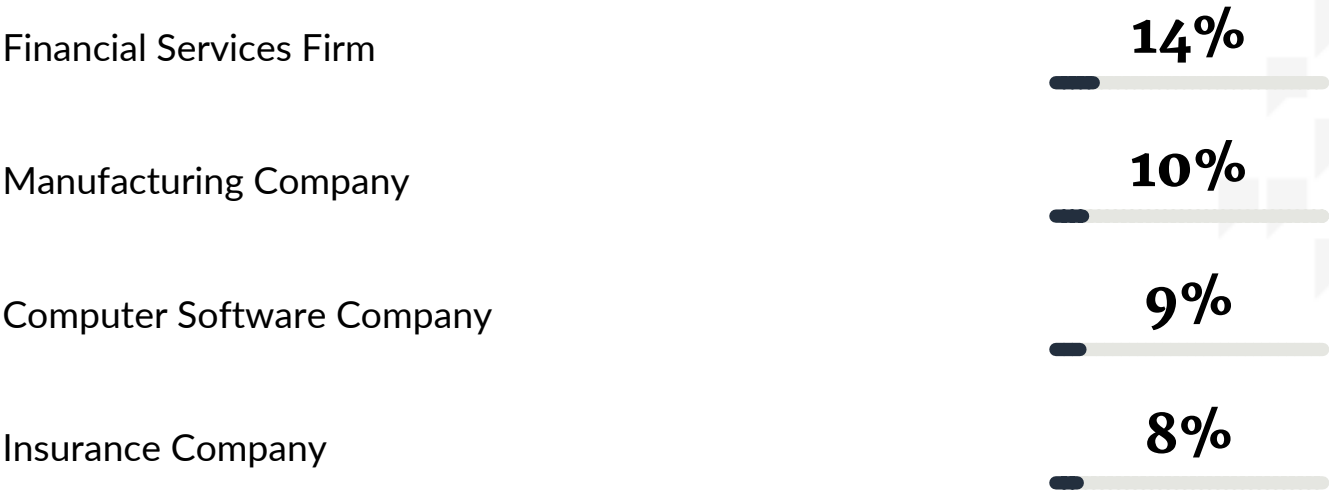

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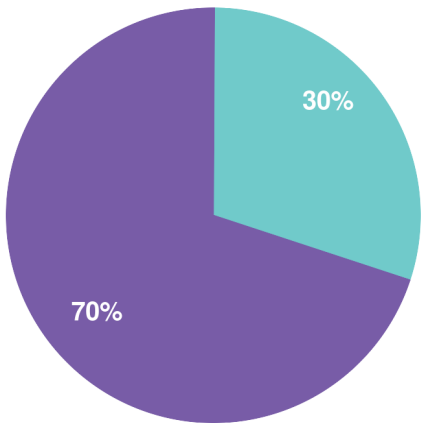

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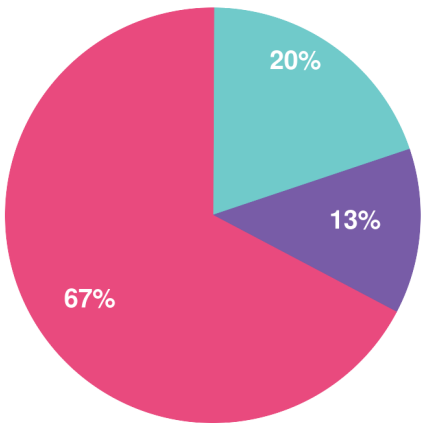
