The files associated with the user can go to Sharepoint 2016 Standard, and the link can be stored into the SAP database so that whatever documents are needed, they can be accessed from the SAP side and quickly retrieved from Sharepoint 2016 Standard.

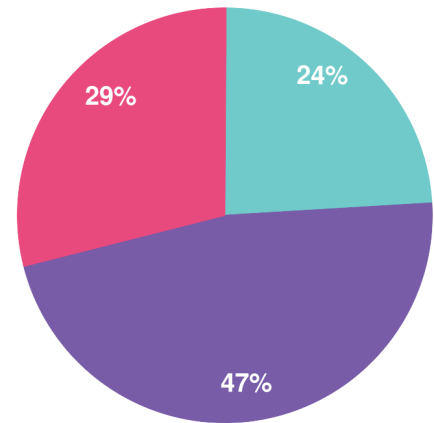
