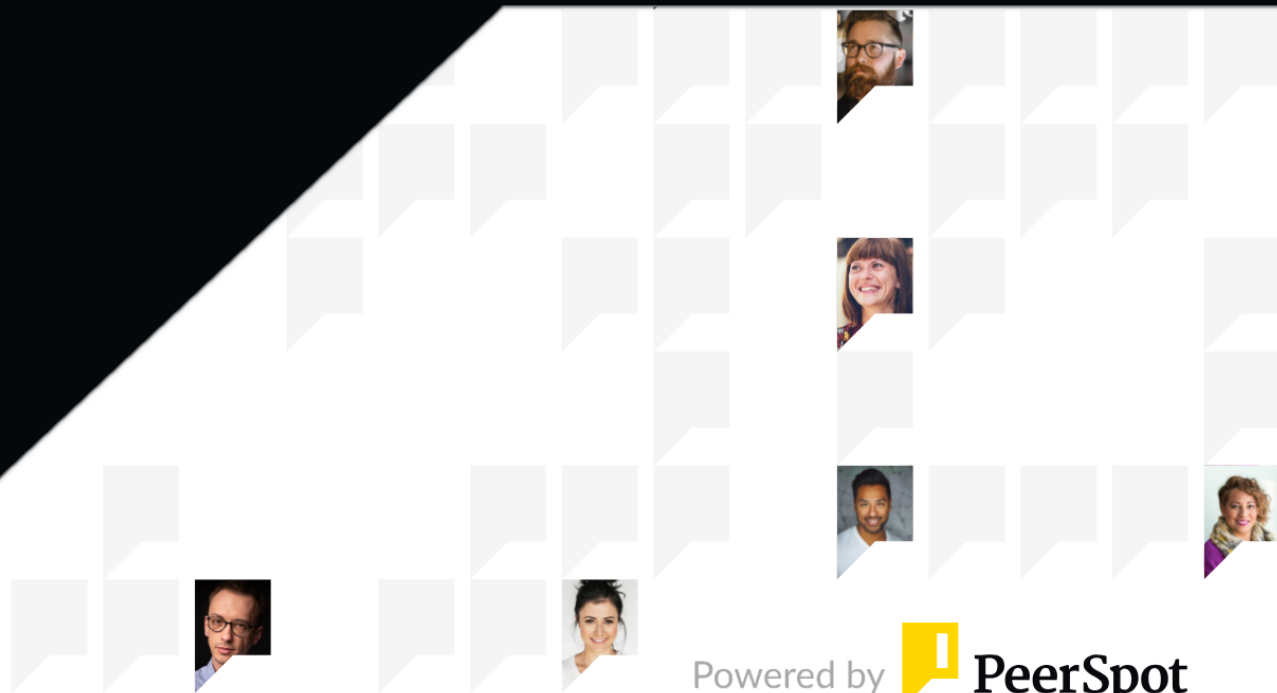

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“My advice is on what they are already using. For example, if it's in a Data Center customer and he already has some security devices and servers. And I would ask him what kind of functionality you want if this can already be set up in a firewall because I'm working very much with FortiGate [Firewalls](#), which also provide load-balancing functionalities. But only up to a specific level, and if it's simple load balancing, round drop into two servers, then you can do it with the firewall. So you don't need an extra device like a dedicated load balancer. But when it comes to load balancing for an exchange platform or another. For the same customer, we replaced the [Microsoft TMG](#) with [Kemp LoadMaster](#). Then you have to deal with things and features. For this, you need then this dedicated load to balance the device. So it depends on the functionalities that one requires.

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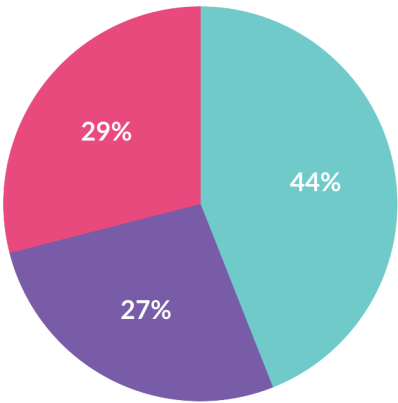
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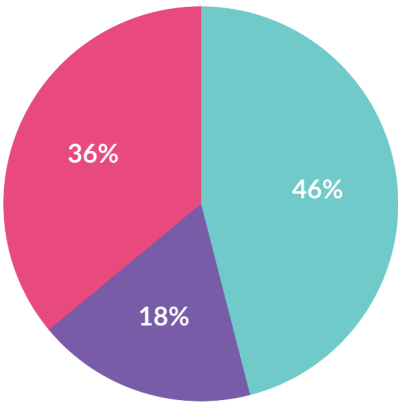
